# Request

#### **C.6.1 MODIFICATIONS**

- (a) The use of the following items is in general unrestricted, except that such items shall not be used in such a way as to create a fitting or extend a function of a permitted fitting:
- (i) shockcord, with a maximum diameter of 5 mm;
- (ii) adhesive tape
- (iii) rings
- (iv) ropes of any length and diameter may be added as long as it does not create a new function to the boat.
- (v) plastic balls
- (vi) blocks with a maximum sheave diameter of 20mm may be added provided it does not create a new function.

INTERPRETATION REQUEST: Is the addition of turning blocks in the traveler system considered "new function"? See pictures below. A single block is added to the aft crossbar bolt on each side.

### **DISCUSSION:**

The traveler system is a good tool for the foiling N17 and to take full advantage of its potential to aid in creating the power to foil, it must be easily adjustable. The additional blocks add needed purchase to deal with the loads on the traveler from awkward angles from the trapeze. This adaptation will help the smaller female skippers.
